

Current Resumption Status of Civil Jury Trials in State of New Jersey

County of New Jersey	Status of Civil Jury Trial	Limitations
Atlantic	Not yet resumed	<p>Each county is following the same limitations in regard to the resumption of in-person civil jury trials.</p> <p>In-person civil jury trials are expected to commence on or after June 15, 2021.</p> <p>The jury selection process will begin virtually. Once jurors are selected, their service may continue either virtually through Zoom, or by reporting to a courthouse following specific COVID-19 safety precautions. This “virtual or in-person” summons option will apply to jury pools scheduled to report on or after June 15, 2021.</p> <p>Civil cases that are especially urgent will be prioritized for in-person trials. Assigned judges may prioritize additional in-person civil jury trials based on local resources.</p> <p>To avoid inadvertent broadcast of jurors, jury selection will not be live broadcast. A limited number of individuals will be permitted to attend the in-person civil trial.
